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Fleece Blanket Edging Flowers In The Garden

G-hook

Worsted weight yarn: A = variegated B = solid green

Bobble: sc in sc indicated, ch 3, sl st in same sc



Round 1 on Right Side with A:

Begin in a hole on the side of the fleece. Attach the yarn with a sl st and ch 1. *Sc in the next hole, ch 1* along the side.

In the corner hole (sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1, sc, ch 1). Repeat from * to * along each side and from (to) in each corner hole. At the end of the round: sl st to top of 1st ch1.

Round 2 on Right Side with A:

Ch 3, sl st in same stitch at the base of ch 3, ch 2, *skip (ch 1, sc, ch 1), sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc, ch 2*. Repeat from * to * across the side.

In the corner: (sc in sc, ch 3, sl st in same sc, ch 1, skip ch) x 2, sc in next sc, ch 3, sl st in same st, ch 2, skip (ch, sc, ch). At the end of the round: sl st to bottom of 1st ch3 with yarn B, ch 3 and turn.



Round 3 on Wrong Side with B:

2 hdc in the space between bobbles and covering yarn from rows 1 & 2, ch 1, 2 hdc in next space. Continue around entire edge. End with 2 hdc in 1st space, sl st in 2nd chain in beginning chain.

NOTE: As you work row 3, pull the bobbles to the right side.
