


NO-SEW FLEECE BLANKET

Supplies: 1 1/2 yards polar fleece
ball point pen very sharp fabric scissors masking tape



Step 1: Using sharp scissors and a long ruler, remove the selvage from each edge along the length of the fleece. The trimmed edge should be a straight, smooth line.



Step 2: Cut a four inch square out of each corner of the fleece.

Step 3: With the fabric laying flat on a table, place the masking tape from one side to the other, four inches from the bottom edge of the fabric. Use the 4" cut-out corners as a guide.

Step 4: Using a ruler, mark lines every inch along the masking tape with a ball point pen. DO NOT mark directly on the fabric.



Step 5: Starting from one side, cut a straight line up to the tape at each mark. The fringe will measure 1" x 4."

Step 6: Tie a knot in the middle of each fringe. Do not tie the fringe too tightly or at the base of the fringe and do not tie two pieces of fringe together.



Step 7: Repeat on the remaining 3 sides.

No Sew Fleece Blanket Important Notes!

- Fleece blankets for Project Linus should be made with one layer of fleece, not two.
- Project Linus cannot accept any blankets that have been made or stored in a smoking environment.
- If you have a pet, please wash & dry the blanket and place in a plastic bag before donating.
- We only accept fleece blankets that are larger than 44" x 44."
- Make sure the length of the blanket is in proportion to the width--not long & narrow!
- Use only polar fleece. Do not use flannel, cotton, wool or corduroy.
- Fleece blankets should lay flat! Check your blanket by spreading it out on a table. If it does not lay flat, the fringe has been knotted too tightly. Please loosen the knots.
