CORNER TO CORNER HEART BLOCK

This block is created using the [Corner to Corner](#) pattern
 Each square on Graph equals one block of the pattern
 H hook, worsted weight (4 ply) yarn
 Finished size-12" square

Explanation of Instruction Grid

ROWS—How many blocks of each color to make

Row numbers on Grid match number on the Graph.
 Begin at lower right hand corner.

*indicates decrease on one side begins with this row

**indicates decrease on both sides begins with this row

DIRECTION

Shows you are working from left **UP** or right **DOWN**

EXAMPLES: Row 10—start on the right and work down

Row 11—start on bottom and work up

COLORS

B-Background Color C-Shape Color

EXAMPLES: B1-1 block in background color

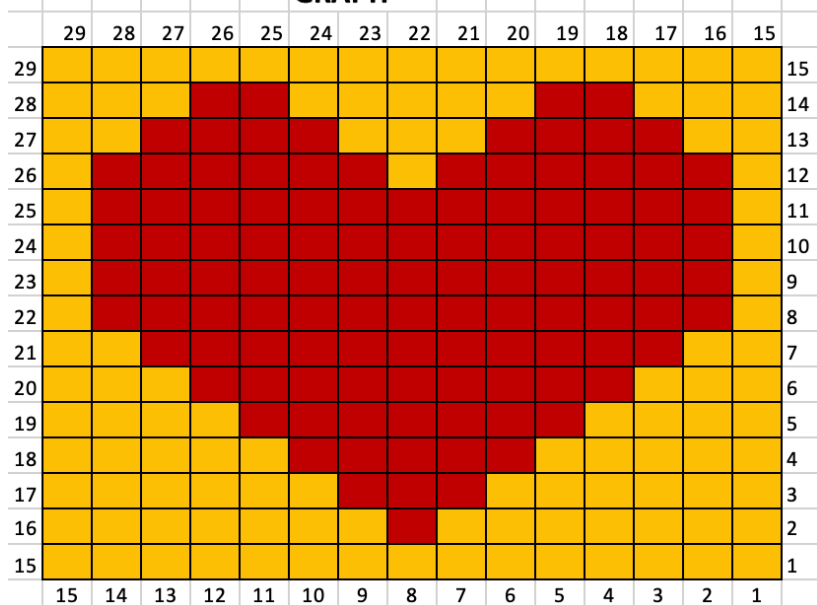
C2-2 blocks in shape color

Row 10-B1 C7 B2 1 block background, 7 blocks shape color, 2 blocks background color
