



Easy Pieced Envelope Quilt Pattern

This pattern works up quick and easy.
It is a wonderful way to quilt our
“Kids Helping Kids” squares!

Fabric Requirements:

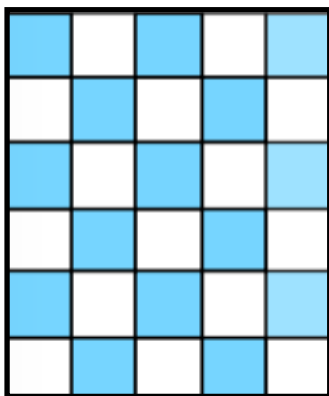
(15) 8-1/2” decorated Kids Helping Kids squares

(15) 8-1/2” cotton fabric squares . Fabric can be all the same or different patterns. Wash before cutting

1-1/2 yards fleece or flannel (for backing)

Sewing Directions:

1. Using 1/4” seams, sew the 8-1/2” squares together in 6 rows of 5, alternating the decorated Kids Helping Kids squares with the cotton fabric squares. Press seams in alternating directions on each row.
2. Sew rows together and press seams in one direction.
3. Place backing fabric (fleece or flannel) right side up on a large surface. Place pieced quilt top, right side down on top of backing fabric. Pin layers together.
4. Stitch 1/4” seam all around sides of the blanket, removing all pins as you sew. Leave a 7” opening.
5. Trim off extra backing fabric and turn right sides out. Topstitch 1/8” seam all around the edge of blanket to quilt pieces together and close opening.
6. Lightly quilt or tie the blanket to hold the two pieces together. If tying, use embroidery floss instead of yarn.
7. You can add 2” wide strips to all sides of quilt top for a border.
8. CHECK FOR PINS!!
