Blue Bells Blanket

SIZE: 36" x 40" inches.

NEEDLES: Size 6 or size needed to obtain gauge

YARN: 4-ply worsted


GAUGE: 9 stitches=2 inches

Cast on 199. Knit 4 rows. Next row: K4, place marker on needle, K to last 4, place marker on needle, K4.

Row 1: K4, sl marker, work in pattern on the center 191 st, sl marker, K4.

Repeat Row 1 until blanket is about 39 1/2 inches long.

End: K4 rows. Bind off. On right side, crochet 1 row of sc around blanket, increasing in corners.



Row 1 ~ Right side: K7, *P1, K7, repeat from * across.

Row 2 and all even Rows: K the K st and P the P st as they face you.

Row 3:* P1, K5, P1, K1, repeat from * across, end P1, K5, P1.

Row 5: K1, P1 *K3 P1, repeat * across. End K1

Row 7: K2, P1, K1, P1, * K5, P1, K1, P1, repeat * across. End K2.

Row 9: K3, *P1, K7, repeat * across, end P1, K3.

Row 11: repeat row 7

Row 13: repeat row 5

Row 15: repeat row 3

Row 16: Repeat row 2.

Repeat these 16 rows for pattern.
