Fleece Blanket Edging

Fans

Skill Level: Easy

Foundation Row / Rnd 1: With right side of fleece facing you, join yarn with a slip-stitch in any hole but the corner hole. Ch 1. * (Sc in next hole, ch 1). Repeat from * until the corner hole. Turn fleece edge under as you go. Work 3 sc in the corner hole, then ch 1. Continue with sc, ch 1 around the blanket, working 3 sc in the corner hole. Join to first chain with a slip-stitch.



Rnd 2: Continuing from foundation row, ch 1. * Sc in every sc and ch to corner. 3 sc in corner sc (middle stitch from corner below). Repeat from * around blanket. Join with slip-stitch to first ch.



Rnd 3: Ch 1, skip next 2 sc. * (5 dc in next sc, skip next 2 sc, sc in next sc, skip next 2 sc). Repeat from * around blanket. Join with slip-stitch to first ch 1. Finish off.



Note: Suggested hook size – G or H

Legend: rnd = round ch=chain sc=single crochet
