

## Mindless Afghan

This pattern is reversible and may be made in any size depending on weight of yarn, the number of stitches in foundation chain and the size of hook used.

Foundation chain is length of afghan.

To change color: Bring new color through the last two loops of the sc at the end of the row.

### Row 1 (right side):

With primary color, chain desired length, sk 2 ch (counts as 1 sc).

Work 1 hdc and 1 dc in next ch, \*sk 2 ch, sc, hdc, dc in next ch\*.

Repeat from \* to \* across to within last 3 ch (if only 1 or 2 ch remain it will still work). Skip 2 ch, sc in last ch, turn.

### Row 2:

Ch 1 (counts as first sc), work hdc and dc in same stitch, \*sk 2 st, sc, hdc, dc in next st\*. Repeat from \* to \* across to within last 2 st. Skip 1 st, sc in next st, turn. (The pattern will be worked in the single crochet in the row below)



Repeat row 2 until afghan is desired size. Change colors as the creative spirit moves you! On final row do not turn, work border.

### Border:

Working across side edge, work \*sc, hdc, dc in same space\*. Repeat from \* to \* in every other row. At corner work sc, hdc, 3 dc in same space. Working across chain edge \*sk 2 ch, sc, hdc, dc in next ch\*. Repeat from \* to \* across foundation chain, work corner. Repeat from \* to \* along other edge, work corner, fasten off.
