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PICOT

FLEECE BLANKET EDGING

(Using skip stitch prepared fleece)

Foundation Row:

Rnd 1: With right side of fleece facing you, join yarn with a slip-stitch in any hole but the corner hole. Ch 1. * (Sc in next hole, ch 1). Repeat from * until the corner hole.

Turn fleece edge under as you go. Work 3 sc in the corner hole, then ch 1. Continue with sc, ch 1 around the blanket, working 3 sc in the corner hole. Join to first chain with a slip-stitch.

Note: You can stop at this point – this makes a very nice blanket, too.

**Instructions for the pattern below are based on round 2 however it can be left out.

Rnd 2: Continuing from foundation row, ch 1. * Sc in every sc and ch to corner.

3 sc in corner sc (middle stitch from corner below). Repeat from * around blanket.

Join with slip-stitch to first ch.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *(skip next sc, sc in next sc, ch 3) across to within one sc of corner sc. Skip next sc, (sc, ch 3) twice in corner sc. Repeat from * around blanket. Join with slip-stitch to first ch.

Rnd 4: Slip-stitch in first ch-3 sp. Ch 1, sc in same sp, work picot.

* (sc in next ch-3 sp, work Picot) across to next corner ch-3 sp.

(Sc, work Picot) twice in corner ch-3 sp. Repeat from * around blanket. Join with slip-stitch to first sc. Finish off.

To work PICOT, ch 3, slip-stitch in third ch from hook.

Note: Suggested hook size – G or H
