

## Scallops of Color

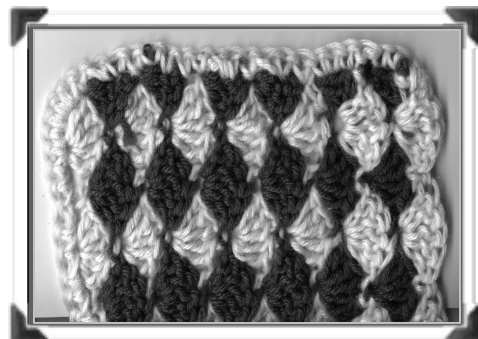
APPROXIMATE SIZE: 42" x 54"

YARN: Approximately 24 ounces of yarn needed.

If made with white every other row it creates a look of lighter color on one side.

GAUGE: 5 dc shell, sc = 2"

\*Note: This afghan is worked lengthwise, from top to bottom.)



Chain 158

Row 1:

Sc in second chain from hook, Sk 2 ch,

\*5 dc in next ch (shell made),

skip 2 ch, sc in next ch, skip 2 ch

repeat from \* across to last 4 ch, shell in next ch, skip 2 ch, sc in last ch

26 shells, cut yarn, turn

Row 2:

Join new color in sc, ch3 for first dc, 2 dc in same st (half shell made at beg of row),

\*sc in center dc of next shell, shell in next sc, repeat from \* across to last shell,

sc in center of shell, 3 dc in last sc (half shell made)

cut yarn, turn

Row 3:

Join new color in first dc, sc

\*shell in next sc, sc in center of next shell; repeat from \* across

end with 3 dc in last sc.

cut yarn, turn

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until desired width.

\*Added Note: A sc edge helps hide the ends.
