

## Barb's Single-Crochet Ripple

APPROXIMATE SIZE: 40" x60"

HOOK: size I or J hook

YARN: 4-ply worsted yarn

Chain (ch) 196 (for 13 patterns, 15 stitches each, plus one at end)

Attach stitch marker at each peak stitch (16, 31, 46, etc.)

ch 3 to turn; single-crochet (sc) in 3rd chain from hook (number 196),

ch 1,

\*[skip next ch, sc, ch] 2 times, skip next ch, sc, skip next 2 ch, sc, ch, [skip next ch, sc, ch] 2 times, skip next ch, sc-ch-sc in same stitch (this is the one that has the stitch marker, and will be the top of the ripple-peak), ch \*

repeat from \* to \* until 13 patterns have been completed; sc, ch 3 to turn.

sc in 3rd ch from hook (just beyond the edge of the work)

repeat the 13 patterns, making each sc in the chain in the previous row – including the sc-ch-sc at the top of the peak in the previous row.

Be sure there is no ch between the 2 sc's at the bottom of each peak (where you skip 2).

The 13 patterns will be about 40" wide, and about 160 rows will be about 60" long.
