

# 6" Square part I

Use up those yarn scraps by knitting and assembling 6" squares for Linus!

#### Guidelines:

Yarn Weight	Needle Size	Approximate Gauge, (sts / 4")
Dk (#3)	5	22
Worsted (#4)	8	19
Bulky (#5)	10	15-19

Patterns are written for dk, with changes for worsted and bulky written in parenthesis. For each of the patterns below, work the given pattern rows until the square measures 6", then bind off. These are suggestions for simple squares:

## Garter Square:

Cast on 33 (29, 24) sts. Knit until piece measures 6 inches. Bind off.

#### Broken Rib:

Cast on 34 (30, 26) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end. Row 2 (WS): Knit.

#### K2, P2, Rib:

Cast on 38 (34, 30) sts.

Row 1 (RS): K2, \*p2, k2; rep from \* to end. Row 2 (WS): P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

# Cartridge Stitch:

Cast on 33 (29, 24) sts. (RS) Row 1, 3, 4, 6: Knit. (WS) Row 2 and 5: Purl.

## Trinity Stitch:

Cast on 33, (30, 24) sts

Row 1: \*K3, p3; rep from \* across. Repeat Row 1.

# Loop Pattern:

Cast on 34 (30, 24) sts.

Row 1 (RS): Knit

Row 2 (WS): \*K1, sl 1; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2. Row 3: Knit.

Row4: K2,\*sl1, k1, rep from\*to end.
