## Materials needed:

From each of a white and print fabric:
18-5 $1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{114 "}{}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ squares - cut in half diagonally, making 36 triangles
$18-4$ " $\times 4$ " squares - cut in half diagonally, making 36 triangles
From each of two solid fabrics (solid A and solid B):
9-5 $1 / 4$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares - cut in half diagonally, making 18 triangles 9-4" x 4" squares - cut in half diagonally, making 18 triangles

From Print: 5-21/2" strips for inner border
From Solid A: 5-31/2 strips for outer border


## Block Construction:

Work each block in three horizontal rows of three small blocks.

## Example:

top row left - sew large print triangle to large white triangle
top row middle - sew small white triangle to small print triangle - press - sew to large solid A triangle
top row right - sew large solid A triangle to large white triangle
Join together to create the top row
Continue in this way for the remaining rows and then join the three rows to create a single block. When finished,you should have nine blocks measuring 13" x 13" each.

## Finishing the Quilt-

Stitch together three strips of three blocks each to create quilt top. (See image of completed quilt)
Stitch Border 1 ( $21 / 2^{1 "}$ wide strips of print fabric) to top, bottom and sides of quilt top. Add Border $2\left(31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ strips of Solid A) in same manner.
