

## Pinwheel Party

This pattern creates two different 17 1/2" (unfinished) blocks.

To make one Block A and one Block B you will need:

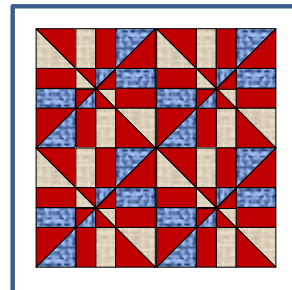
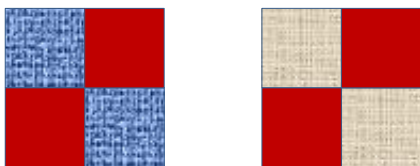
4 – 10" solid or tone on tone background squares

2 – 10" print squares

2 – 10" contrasting print squares

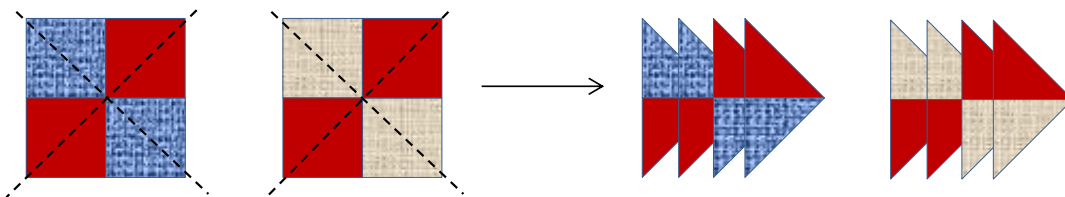
### DIRECTIONS:

1. Make two four-patch blocks as follows and press toward the dark fabric.

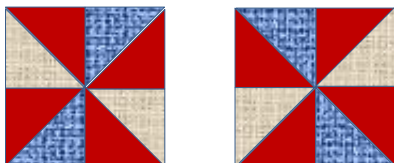


Here's one example of a quilt using 4 – Block A blocks plus a 3" finished border.

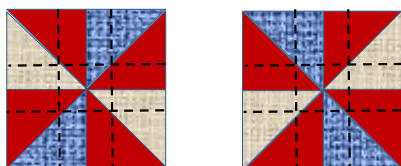
2. Cut each block on both diagonals.



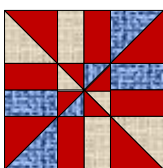
3. Sew squares together as pictured below. You will create two mirror image squares.



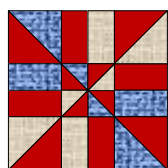
4. Cut block horizontally and vertically, 2 1/2" from the center seams. (Dotted lines)



5. Reposition the double rectangle block pieces as pictured. You can use both Block A and Block B in the same quilt or make two different quilts using 4, 6, etc. of either Block A or Block B. It's a very versatile block!
