

# Crayon Blanket



**FINISHED SIZE: 41" X 52"**

**FIVE CRAYONS EACH MEASURING  
7" X 50" (FINISHED)  
1" (FINISHED) SASHING IN BETWEEN EACH  
CRAYON  
1" (FINISHED) BORDER ON ALL SIDES**

**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS  
1/2 yard for each crayon  
1-1/4 yards black  
(THESE ARE APPROXIMATE AMOUNTS)**

We have included patterns for the Crayon Quilt using two different formats-templates or paper piecing. You can use whichever method you prefer. You will need to copy the patterns to create five crayons. Be sure that your scale on your copies is the same as the original pattern.

Because of the length of the center section of each crayon, you will use a glue stick or Washi tape to connect some of the pages together.

For the Template format, the center section (G & J) prints out in two pages. You will be gluing/taping the pages together. When joining these pages together, match the lines at the top/bottom of the pages and then apply tape/glue. Some templates will be used more than once. To complete each crayon, you will cut 2 copies of G in your crayon color fabric, 6 copies of E (4 black & 2 in your crayon fabric) and 4 copies of "I" in your crayon fabric

For the Paper Piecing format, you will be taping/gluing three pages together. These pages contain Segments A1-A9. When joining these pages, match the lines at the top/bottom of the pages and then apply the tape/glue.
